# HIMSS Interoperability Showcase Overview

This premier exhibition displays the exchange, access and use of data through interoperability profiles and standards in real time with live products currently in the marketplace—backed by the strength of HIMSS's global experience, expertise and thought leadership.

The highest-trafficked area of the HIMSS19 exhibit floor, the Showcase is packed with demonstration areas, a large education theater, a product marketplace and more.

Attendees will get a broad picture of interoperability opportunities and successes with demonstrations on a variety of impactful topics.












## Interoperability Stakeholders

- Government agencies, market suppliers, non-profit organizations, payers, providers, academia, HIEs, standards development organizations, consulting firms, etc.
- More than 100 <u>organizations</u> and 130 demonstrating systems and initiatives signed up to participate at HIMSS20. <u>Over 30% were new organizations to the</u> <u>Interoperability Showcase.</u>
- Participants demonstrate over 450 times to attendees during exhibit hours.



# HIMSS19 Attendee Demographics



## Stats- 2019

- Nearly 11,000 visitors attended, making it the highest trafficked area on the floor.
- 1 out of 4 conference attendees prioritized their visit to this space.
- Visitors spent an average of 40 minutes at the exhibit.
- Attendees gave the exhibit the highest satisfaction rating on the show floor.



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# Ways to Participate

#### Demonstrations

- 7 to 10 organizations collaborate to demonstrate in a single story focused on an individual. Participants work with HIMSS and other organizations to develop unique storylines that explore the value of their interoperability solutions.
- Demonstrations place solutions in a clinical context, allowing attendees to engage in the interoperability story of an individual—such as a caregiver, patient or clinician. Attendees can then witness the impact these systems have on clinical outcomes, quality and patient experience.
- Any technology that exchanges data using interoperability standards can participate.

#### **Education Theater**

• Our Education Theater hosts 60-minute sessions on emerging topics impacting interoperability today. Interoperability trailblazers provide their perspectives and insights on challenges and inroads, and identify opportunities. Nearly 3,000 attendees engaged with our speakers at HIMSS19.

#### Spotlight Theater

• New opportunity to highlight your individual implementation efforts in the industry today and what's in store for the future.

# Demonstration Topics

The HIMSS Interoperability Showcase is looking for new topics for demonstrations at HIMSS21 Global Conference and Exhibition. Please submit your suggestions in our <u>Connected Demonstration Topic Survey!</u>

- We make our selections based on interest (how often a topic comes up in surveys) as well as guidance from our stakeholders.
  - We may combine suggestions to get the most content into our demonstrations.
  - Suggestions with planned participation are given priority.
- The earlier you participate in the Showcase, the more options you have, and the better your experience will be.
  - This affects different organizations more than others but it benefits the whole project the earlier you are able to join.
- Demonstration roles and location assignments are distributed on a first come first serve basis
  - Some organizations select based on participants rather than the role/topic.
  - Marketplace kiosks placement is also assigned by contract date.

## Path 1: Live Demonstrations

7 to 10 participating organizations collaborate to demonstrate in a single story focused on an individual.

- Participants work with HIMSS and other organizations to develop unique storylines that explore the value of their interoperability solutions.
- Each organization bringing its own perspective and story to tell, making each demonstration one-of-a-kind.
- Demonstrations also place the solutions in clinical context, allowing visitors to engage in the interoperability story of an individual such as a caregiver, patient or clinician. They can then witness the impact these systems have on clinical outcomes, quality and the patient experience.

Any technology that exchanges data <u>using interoperability standards</u> are invited to participate in our connected demonstrations.



# How do you select which topic to participate in?

Your selection can be based on

- The topic (Diabetes treatment and care),
- Other participants, or
- A type of exchange you would like to demonstrate
- Location of the Demonstration: Some demonstrations will be primary presented virtually and will be featured onsite.

# Premier (Limited Available)

- Organizations who have multiple products or a single product that exchanges information in multiple settings.
  - Option 1: If your technologies have a variety of uses and are deployed in many health environments/scenarios you can participate in multiple topics under one level or participation.
  - Option 2: Organizations that want to lead a demonstration topic with a limited number of partners in a single demonstration. You will also determine if this demonstration will be primarily in person or virtual. (Limited Availability)
- Expanded Marketing opportunities including a 60 minute education session on our main stage.



# Reminder: Demonstration Topics

The HIMSS Interoperability Showcase is looking for new topics for demonstrations at HIMSS21 Global Conference and Exhibition. Please submit your suggestions in our Connected Demonstration Topic Survey!

# Minimum Requirements

- You must use an interoperability standard to exchange information (such as an HL7 Profile, IHE Profile\*, DICOM, DIRECT, etc.). No proprietary exchanges will be allowed in the demonstrations.
  - \*If you are demonstrating an IHE profile you must register, attend, and successfully pass the IHE Connectathon (separate fee required). Details on registration are available on <a href="www.iheusa.org">www.iheusa.org</a>.
- Participation in a weekly virtual meeting to plan your demonstration starting April 2021.
- Attendance at set up for 2 days prior to HIMSS Global Health Conference (9 am-5 pm PST) and during all exhibit hours. Virtual attendance can be arranged by written permission from HIMSS.
- All HIMSS21 Showcase participants are strongly encouraged to attend the IHE North American Virtual Connectathon & Conference in March 2021 to ensure that demonstrations are sound, to identify any concerns, and to collaborate with other testing partners. HIMSS21 Interoperability Showcase participants are entitled to discounts at the IHE North American Virtual Connectathons in 2021. See iheusa.org for more information about discount information.



# How do I know if I need to <u>register</u> for the IHE Connectathon?

In order to participate in a live demonstration, you must use an exchange standard in order to share your information, such as a HL7 Profile, IHE Profile, DICOM, IEEE, etc. We do not allow proprietary exchanges in the connected demonstrations.

• If you are demonstrating an IHE profile you must register, attend and successfully pass the IHE North American Virtual Connectathon & Conference (separate fee required). Your system must have tested that profile at a Global IHE Connectathon within 12 months priors to conference. ## Early Bird Period Ends - December 2020

- Once topics are selected, all early bird participants will have early access to our topics!
   Demonstration placement is on a first come first serve basis.
- Topics are expanded by those who participate in them. The descriptions of these demonstrations are guidelines, but often change based on the organizations participating.

## Demonstration Calls Begin - Spring 2021

- Live Demonstrations begin to meet together to develop their demonstration. These
  weekly calls will continue until the conference. Join your demonstration before this time to
  make the most of your benefits. Topics are expanded by those who participate in them
  and often change based on the organizations participating.
- A Project Manager will be assigned to each demonstration to help guide and meet deadlines on weekly calls.
  - Determine images

  - Technical transactions



## **Timeline**

### Conference

- Attendance is required at set up for
  - 2 days prior to HIMSS Global Conference
  - During all exhibit hours (Tuesday-Thursday from 9am-6pm and additional events).
- In the interoperability Showcase there is something about to start every 15 minutes. Our demonstrations are split into two groups and half start at 15 and the other start at 45 past every hour, our education sessions begin at the half hour and our networking events start at the top of every hour.

- 20-minute thought leadership session within the Interoperability Showcase.
- New opportunity to highlight your individual implementation efforts in the industry today and what's in store for the future.
- Limited staffing needed during a specific time during the conference.



## User Experience Posters

- Partner with clients and share a successful interoperability user story.
- Exhibit an impactful project underway.
- No onsite staffing needed during exhibit hall hours.
- Will be presented in a socially distanced area of the pavilion and digitally.
