HIMSS will implement health and safety protocols appropriate to the public health circumstances existing at the time of the conference.


Those protocols may include but are not limited to the following:



- Up to ten (10) participating organizations collaborate to demonstrate a single story focused on an individual.
- All participants by use interoperability and health standards to ensure they're able to demonstrate real-world data exchange.
- Participants work with HIMSS staff and other organizations to develop unique storylines that explore the value of their interoperability solutions.
- Each organization brings its own perspective and story to share, ensuring each demonstration is one-of-a-kind.

Minimum Participation Requirements

- All participants must use an interoperability standard to exchange information (such as an HL7 Profile, IHE Profile*, DICOM, DIRECT, etc.). No proprietary exchanges will be allowed in the demonstrations.
 - *If you are demonstrating an IHE profile you must have successfully passed an IHE Connectathon (separate fee required) within the last 24 months of the HIMSS Global Conference Interoperability Showcase. Details on registration are available on www.iheusa.org.
- Participation in a weekly virtual meeting to plan your demonstration starting in April 2021.
- Attendance at set up for two (2) days prior to HIMSS21 (9:00 am-5:00 pm) and during all exhibition hours.
- All HIMSS21 Showcase participants are strongly encouraged to attend the *IHE North American Virtual Connectathon & Conference* from March 1-5, 2021 to connect and collaborate with other testing partners around demonstration topics. HIMSS21 Interoperability Showcase participants are entitled to discounts to this event. See iheusa.org for more information about discount information.

Demonstration Development

Your selection can be based on the following:

- The topic (e.g. immunization management)
- Other participants
- A type of exchange you would like to demonstrate
- Type of demonstration: in-person or digital

Premier (Limited Availability)

- Organizations who have multiple products or a single product that exchanges information across multiple settings
 - Option 1: If your technologies have a variety of uses and are deployed in many health environments/scenarios you can participate in multiple topics under one level of participation.
 - Option 2: Organizations that want to lead a demonstration topic with a limited number of partners in a single demonstration. You will determine if this demonstration will allow hybrid participation or if it will be in the cloud.
- Opportunity to participate in a 60-minute educational session at the Showcase Education Theater
- Enhanced market visibility & presence

Digital Participation within Demonstrations

This is an in-person demonstration with digital participation at HIMSS21.

- Minimum of four (4) in-person participants within each demonstration.
- Up to four (4) digital participants allowed within each demonstration.
- Whether you choose to be an in-person or digital participant, there is no variation of expectations during the planning and development of a demonstration.
- Digital participants are expected to participate in real-time exchanges and visibly show their solutions within the demonstration.
- In case a digital participant's connectivity goes down, there must be static content available in the interim.

Digital Participation within Demonstrations

- For digital participants, the following will be provided:
 - Dedicated Zoom feed through a monitor inside the in-person demonstration
 - Within each hybrid demonstration there will be a dedicated workstation with a large display monitor for all digital participants via Zoom
 - Ability to send content/whitepaper in advance and will add to the appropriate on-site space
- Digital participants must be available during the following times:
 - Two (2) days prior to HIMSS21 Global Conference for demonstration set-up and run-through (e.g. connecting to the network, hardware set-up, etc.).
 - During all HIMSS21 Global Conference exhibition hours

Thought Leadership & Exhibition

Timeline & Next Steps...

Timeline

- **February, 2021 (today!):** Demonstration topics posted online & sign-up for **all** participants begins.
 - Don't see a specific role mentioned in a topic? Reach out to Showcase@himss.org and we can help identify which demonstration you can make the biggest impact.
- **April, 2021:** Scheduling of Demonstration Project Calls; calls begin first week of May, 2021
- **May-August, 2021:** Demonstration meetings ongoing
 - All participants begin weekly meetings (60 min; virtual) to develop their individual demonstrations with staff; these weekly calls will continue until HIMSS21.
 - Join your demonstration before this time to make the most of your benefits. Topics are expanded by those who participate in them and often change based on the roster of organizations included.
 - A Project Manager is assigned to each demonstration to help streamline, guide and meet deadlines during weekly meetings.
 - Storyline viability
 - Technical transactions
 - Determine onsite space design & graphics

Timeline (Cont'd)

- **August 9-13**
 - Attendance is required at set-up, including:
 - 2-days prior to HIMSS21
 - During all exhibit hours (Tuesday-Thursday from 9:00 am-6:00 pm & additional events)
 - Between demonstrations, educational sessions and networking opportunities, an event begins approximately every 15-minutes within the Showcase.
 - Demonstrations are split into two groups and half start at 15 and the other start at 45 past every hour
 - Education sessions begin at the half hour
 - Networking events start at the top of every hour



How to Use the Demonstration Topic Sheet


- Column A: **Draft Title of the use case**- This will change in the fall after all participation has been identified.


